Cell phone use is NOT permitted in the classroom. Certain times we will use phones in class and we will notify you. Violation of policy will result in a behavior referral.

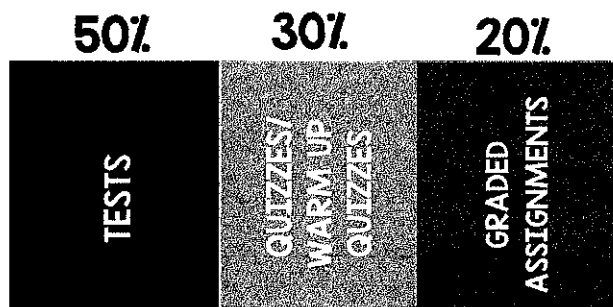

TESTS: Tests will be given at the end of each unit.

Tests will be designed to model the Algebra Examination, including "multiple choice" and "show your work" questions. All tests are cumulative, meaning they cover material from the entire school year.

QUIZZES: Quizzes/warm up quizzes will be given periodically throughout each unit (approximately once a week). At the end of each marking period, the lowest quiz grade will be dropped.

WARM-UPS: You will be completing warm-up problems every day at the beginning of class. Once a week, you will have a warm-up quiz, based on that weeks topics.

MIDTERM/FINAL EXAM

You will be taking a Midterm exam during the January exam week. The Midterm will count for two test grades, one in the 2nd quarter and one in the 3rd. Your final exam will be during the finals week at the end of the school year. Both exams will be cumulative.
