ADDING, SUBTRACTING, MULTIPLYING, DIVIDING FRACTIONS:

Just type it in (with parentheses around each fraction). Get your answer as a reduced fraction by pressing_____.

For example, to do $\frac{1}{3} + \frac{3}{8}$, you type in _____.

TRY: $\frac{3}{16} + \frac{4}{5}$

$$\frac{7}{8} - \frac{1}{3}$$

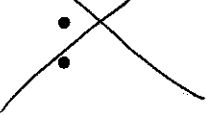
$$\frac{2}{3} \cdot \frac{4}{9}$$

WHEN YOU HAVE "STUFF" ON THE TOP OR BOTTOM OF A FRACTION:

By "stuff," we mean addition, subtraction, etc.

Type in the top and bottom separately. Then simplify!

For example, $\frac{6+18}{12-10} =$

TRY: $\frac{20+12 \cdot 3}{3+4} =$

$$\frac{120-118}{15+35} =$$

$$\frac{20^2-5^2}{360-355} =$$
